TimeBanking Frequently Asked Questions?

Is this like bartering? A bit. However in TimeBanking your “banked hours” can be used for any service from any member. Bartering typically operates between two individuals or entities whereas TimeBanking involves an entire community network.

What if I think my time is worth more than another’s time? In TimeBanking all hours are equal. Timebanking has a simple formula of 1=1.

What if I don’t need anything? We believe everyone has something to offer and something they need. However, we also have a Community Account where hours can be donated. These can be used to underwrite hours to organizational members or to the TimeBank for the help we need to operate.

What if I don’t have a computer to see the offers and requests? The Member Coordinator who meets with you will share ways you can participate if you don’t have a computer.

How it works.

1. You Join Our Network by Contacting us.

A Member Coordinator will meet with you.

2. You Get an Online "Timebank Account."

You list your offers and requests and begin to exchange: You offer a service to another member and bank your time. You use your time for services from others.

3. Everyone benefits.

Exchanges run the TimeBank. You "co-own" the TimeBank as well.
